Origin: Gualtallary, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

Altitude: 1350 m.a.s.l.

Soil: sandy alluvial soil with silt and calcareous. They are poor in organic matter and have excellent drainage. Therefore, the vines explore the deepest layers of the soil and establish roots pronounced

Composition: 80% Malbec - 20% Petit Verdot

Plots: Barracks 1 "Malena" (Malbec) and Barracks 9B "Edith Piaf" (Petit Verdot) from Finca Las Divas

Winemaker: José Hernández Toso

Aging: 12 months in French oak barrels and foudres

Aging potential: 10 years

Alcohol: 14,3 % / **PH:** 3,7 / **Residual sugar:** 3,26 gr

TASTING NOTES

This great blend reflects the character of the strength of the soil of our vineyard in Gualtallary. Purplish deep red color, its aromas are intense and concentrated, with notes of black and red fruits with smoky touches of his aging. Persistent in the mouth with juicy and firm tannins, balanced acidity. It is straight and expressive, modern and with a great personality.
